POLICY

Honda of the UK Manufacturing Ltd strives to be a company that society wants to exist. This policy outlines our commitment to ensuring the health, safety and welfare of our associates and others affected by our actions. This policy also outlines our commitment to protecting the environment from our environmental risks and energy uses.

At Honda we recognise our responsibility to ensure the health, safety and welfare of all associates and that of others affected by our operations on and off site. We are committed to protecting the environment from the effects of our operations.

We recognise the importance of health, safety, environmental and energy legislation and will comply with legal requirements applicable to our operations. We will follow relevant guidance, standards that apply to our operations.

We support a culture that promotes and communicates wellbeing, as well as mitigating the risk of injury, illness, and/or harmful effects to the environment.

This policy and associated Honda policy statements shall be communicated at all levels within Honda.

We will:

- Provide safe and healthy working conditions to prevent work related injuries and ill health.
- Where reasonably practicable, we will firstly strive to eliminate hazards.
- Where hazards cannot be eliminated, identify, evaluate, manage, and reduce health, safety, and environmental risks associated with our operations.
- Ensure competence of those who undertake activities on behalf of Honda through the provision of information, instruction, training and necessary resources to achieve objectives.
- Promote health, safety, and environmental awareness.
- Identify and implement the means for prevention of pollution and minimising our impact on the environment.
- Review and update the health, safety, and environmental management system as necessary.

All associates, on site contractors and visitors are expected to understand and comply with this policy and the supporting arrangements. These are outlined in the standards and procedures that establish the health, safety and environmental management system in place at Honda.

To enable effective implementation of this policy Honda will nominate competent person(s) to advise and support Honda top management on health, safety, and environmental issues.
